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Weak Two

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This Topic provides you with hands where you get to practice your weak two openings. Opener has a six-card major, 5 to 10 high card points and responder can hold a variety of hands.

In this document we follow the bid72 Guru-convention card for intermediates and open these hands with 2♥ or 2♠. When responder relays with 2NT we show a feature if non-minimum.

In the document in the expert section we discuss a different structure in response to the 2NT relay.

After a 2♠ opening, it's much of the same:

After the response to 2NT, responder usually decides on the contract. If he would bid a new suit instead, that is natural and forcing. Bids on the four level are cuebids in support of partners major.
